School Locations > 99

- The Office of Postsecondary Education Identifier (OPEID) is the unique combination of the 6-digit school code and the 2-digit school location code.
- NSLDS is now able to accept and process data for schools with more than 99 locations.

School Locations > 99

- When a school has more than 99 locations, the first digit of the OPEID is incremented to 1. If the school has more than 199 locations, the first digit is then incremented to 2, and so forth.
- NSLDS can now receive and process OPEIDs where the first digit is 1-9.

Maximum Eligibility Period

- The Maximum Eligibility Period is 150% of the published length of borrower's current educational program.
 - Calculated by COD based on disbursement records.
 - Multiply published length of program by 1.5.
 - NSLDS will calculate using Enrollment Reporting information.
 - Schools will be required to report individual student's program-level enrollment data to NSLDS.

Loss of Subsidy

NSLDS determines if Loss of Interest Subsidy should occur on a borrower's loan based on the borrower's Remaining Eligibility Period (REP) and program-level enrollment status.


- NSLDS will display the Loss of Subsidy icon and information on the NSLDS websites.
- NSLDS will include Loss of Subsidy in TSM, FAH, and selected NSLDS Reports.
- NSLDS will send Loss of Subsidy data to the federal loan servicers.

- New Consolidation Loan Type – ‘D9’
 - Name: Direct Consolidation Subsidized (SULA Eligible)
 - Code: D9
 - NSLDS will treat the new ‘D9’ loan type similar to the existing ‘D6’ (Direct Consolidated Subsidized) loan type.

Prescreening & Postscreening



New Enrollment Reporting Guide

- Use the monitoring tools and information in the Guide (now available on IFAP) to ensure that your school is in compliance with enrollment reporting requirements.
- Dear Colleague Letter (DCL) GEN-14-07 reminds schools that they must adhere to all current NSLDS enrollment reporting requirements.

New Enrollment Reporting Guide

- Important changes to the enrollment reporting process:
 - Schools will be required to certify enrollment information at least every 60 days and respond to rosters within 15 days.
 - Original, Enhanced, and XML Enrollment Reporting batch formats will not be supported.
 - New Program-Level and Email Address record types.


- Batch processing has been updated and new record types have been added:
 - Record Type '000' – Header Record
 - Record Type '001' – Campus-Level Enrollment information
 - Record Type '002' – Program-Level Enrollment information
 - Record Type '003' – E-mail Address (Optional)
 - Record Type '999' – Trailer Record
- Layouts are posted on IFAP and included in the ER Guide
- A single update for a student will consist of a bundle of records.

Bundle Concept

- A valid detail record of one type may be rejected by NSLDS because of an error in another detail record in the same student's bundle.
- Each detail record type in the new layout will include a field named 'Bundle Rejected Flag'.
 - This flag will be set to "Y" for all the detail records in a bundle that contain an error, although the actual error code will only be displayed on the detail record that contains the error.

Enrollment Reporting Transition

- **April 2014**
 - Schools are able to report program-level data to NSLDS in batch and/or online on the Enrollment Maintenance page.
- **July 2014**
 - Schools are required to provide enrollment information every 60 days and respond to rosters within 15 days.
 - Schools should update their schedule to comply with new reporting requirements.
 - Schools should select the first reporting date with the new roster format on the Enrollment Reporting Profile page.

Enrollment Reporting Transition

- **July 2014 (continued)**
 - Schools are able to use the new Enrollment Spreadsheet Submittal to report program-level data online.
- **October 1, 2014**
 - Final deadline for reporting under the new reporting requirements.
 - Reporting of program-level enrollment information must be retroactive to the enrollment status of the student as of July 1, 2014.

Importance of Enrollment Data Quality

- Ensure data reported to NSLDS is of the highest quality possible.
- NSLDS will be creating monitoring for schools to identify specific data quality issues.
