PRESENTER BIO: Ian Foss has been with Federal Student Aid (FSA) since 2010. Since joining FSA, he has primarily worked on student loan policy and implementation issues, such as income-driven repayment, Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) and Temporary Expanded PSLF, borrower defense to repayment, interest rates, and the 150% Direct Subsidized Loan Limit (also known as Subsidized Usage Limit Applies or SULA). In 2016, Ian enjoyed the opportunity to serve as a detailed-education policy advisor to Senate Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions (HELP) Committee. Prior to joining FSA, Ian earned his Juris Doctorate in 2010 from the University of Baltimore, where his focus was international and comparative law.
