Deputy Assistant Director, Policy, Planning and Innovation, Office of Postsecondary Education, U.S. Department of Education

Annmarie Weisman currently serves as the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Policy, Planning, and Innovation in the Office of Postsecondary Education (OPE) at the U.S. Department of Education. This office develops federal postsecondary education policy and regulations that support the federal student financial assistance programs and programs authorized by the *Higher Education Act of 1965*, as amended. Additionally, the office administers the review process for accreditation agencies to ensure that education provided by the institutions of higher education meets acceptable levels of quality.



Prior to this position, Annmarie most recently served as Senior Director, Policy Development, Analysis, and Accreditation Services. She has negotiated on behalf of the Department on numerous topics during negotiated rulemaking sessions and has held other policy director positions within OPE since 2015. Annmarie also held multiple positions in Federal Student Aid (FSA), beginning in the Philadelphia regional office in 2007.

Before beginning federal service, Annmarie began her 30+ year career in higher education by working at several schools in admissions, financial aid, housing, and residence life. She also worked for a non-profit federal and private student loan provider.

Annmarie holds a Master of Arts in Education degree from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in College Student Personnel and a Bachelor of Science degree from the Pennsylvania State University in Human Development and Family Studies.
