Byron Scott is a Case Manager for the Multi-Regional and Foreign Schools Participation Division, coordinating oversight activities for a number of publicly-traded or large schools. He is based in Chicago and has been working for Federal Student Aid for over 29 years. He began his federal career in Washington, DC, working with the Default Management and State Liaison Offices. From 1995 to 2010 he worked for the Chicago-Denver School Participation Division as a financial analyst and program reviewer. While in those positions, he also reviewed eligibility applications, resolved audits, and conducted training. From 2010 to 2014 he served as a Training Officer, providing training to institutions individually and at conferences. Prior to working for the Department, he worked in the admission offices for two private colleges, so his entire career has been spent in postsecondary education.
